FORATOM is pleased to announce the election of a new President and Vice President. They will serve the European nuclear industry's trade association, as of 1 December, for a period of 2 years.

The incumbents are as follows:

Dr. Ralf Güldner, Vice Chairman of the Board of Management of E.ON Kernkraft, has been elected President of FORATOM, succeeding Paul Rorive.

Dr. Güldner joined Siemens in 1981 and worked in the nuclear fuel business for twenty years before becoming Managing Director of Framatome ANP, which is now AREVA NP.

In 2006, he was appointed Executive Vice President of AREVA NP responsible for its global nuclear fuel business.

In September 2008, he joined E.ON Kernkraft as Managing Director responsible for new build, decommissioning and fuel management. He has also served as Chairman of the German Nuclear Society and from 2006 – 2008 was Chairman of the World Nuclear Association.

Per-Olof Waessman has been elected Vice President of FORATOM.

Mr Waessman is Chief Nuclear Officer at Vattenfall, where he is responsible for nuclear safety issues and is the Executive Group Management's nuclear expert.

Mr. Waessman has accumulated over thirty years experience in reactor safety and technology, nuclear management, operations and maintenance. Prior to joining Vattenfall he worked for five years as Director of Boiling Water Reactor Technology at Westinghouse Sweden.
